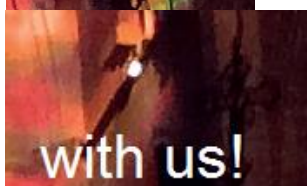
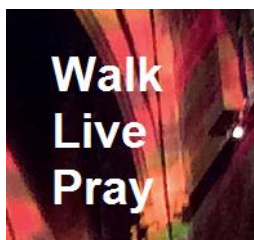
If your answer is 'yes' we'd like to hear from you !

At present we have one resident member living in the house, who has a full-time job, and we have nine non-residential members.

The house has space for four residents, with a shared kitchen, sitting room and garden. Anyone interested in moving into the house is expected to demonstrate a commitment to the St Thomas Pilgrim Community rhythm of life'.

Rent per week is £70 plus a contribution to bills; this is negotiable according to circumstances.
